From the desk of our Pastors . . .

Last week I had an appointment in Wilmington for a minor surgical procedure with my dermatologist. I was not too happy about it but I decided to make the best of the time I had and wrote out a list of things that needed to be done while I was up there. The medical stuff was scheduled for the morning so I made a haircut appointment for the afternoon and figured I could do some banking, a little shopping, and maybe even have lunch with friends. Just to be on the safe side I also grabbed my briefcase and computer so if I had extra time I could camp out in Starbucks and get some work done.

As I was driving up I thought about stopping for coffee and getting gas but I waited to do both until I got to Wilmington. Traffic was light and I ran into no issues on the roads. All seemed to be going along just fine.

That was until I got to the hospital where I was having the procedure done and realized I didn't have my purse. I had no license, no money, no credit or debit cards and no proof of insurance. Without any of that I could not prove who I was so the medical group refused to do the procedure.

So off I went with the intention to finish up with the rest of my to-do list. I figured I would get money at the bank but I could not do that without ID or a debit card. I could not stop for coffee without cash or another way to pay for it. I could not even get gas! I got back in the car and drove back to Milford hoping I would have enough fuel to get there. I made it back on fumes and sure enough, there was my purse on the kitchen table exactly where I had left it.

If I had stopped for gas or coffee on the way north I would have quickly realized I didn't have what I needed and would have been able to turn around. I had left with plenty of

time so I could have made my appointment even with the detour.

It was a nice day for a drive but a massive waste of time. I also have to reschedule the procedure which means I am going to lose another day by heading back to Wilmington.

The only reason I can think of for why I did it was that I am so used to taking just one thing (usually my purse) that when I grabbed the bag holding my computer I was thinking I was good to go. I was more than just a little annoyed with myself.

The question I found myself asking was "what did God want me to learn from this?" Was I moving too fast and not focused on the important things? Was I not giving my concerns over to God about the procedure and was getting a wake-up call to trust the Lord and not be preoccupied with those things that He can handle? Or was it simply an oversight without any divine intention? As a Pastor friend once told me, "sometimes things just happen."

Jeremiah 2:25 (in the Message version) says, "Slow down. Take a deep breath. What's the hurry? Why wear yourself out? Just what are you after anyway? But you say, 'I can't help it. I'm addicted to alien gods. I can't quit.'

Maybe this was supposed to help me answer the question that Pastor Tom asked two weeks ago in the sermon, "what is it you are looking for?" Maybe I am addicted to the alien god of always being busy. Was this God's way of telling me to stop and smell the roses? I really don't want to be so busy that I miss what is going on around me.

Perhaps the next time I go to Wilmington I will have time to see Chris. Maybe that is the silver lining that will come from this. Only God knows at this point. But I think I'll slow down and see what He does. I'm sure that whatever way the Creator takes this, it will be perfect.

Now where did I leave that purse?

HIDDEN FIGURES

If you haven't already, I encourage you to see the movie "Hidden Figures." The story plot of the movie is based on the real lives of three African American women who worked for NASA during the beginning of the space program. In the 1950's and 60's the women who handled the math calculations for the space program were known as "the colored computers." The movie portrays the day to day discrimination they faced with separate bathrooms and coffee pots, disrespect from white co-workers and even from African American men. Yet they persevered and gave significant contributions to the space program that could not have succeeded without them. I am grateful that the real-life Ms. Katherine Johnson, one of the three featured in the movie, received the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2015. This and the movie makes it clear that these brave women are hidden no more.

Yet people who are hidden figures continue to abound in this world of ours. They are people who have done incredible work for the promotion of good in the world and in the church and get little or no acknowledgement. Many times that is due to institutional racism that tends to reward the majority culture at the expense of people of color. Sometimes people become "hidden" because of their gender, class, ability, orientation, or religious preference. Whatever the reason the effect is the same: devaluation, invisibility and a huge loss for all of us. That is because when one of us shines, we all shine. Young people are looking for role models and we need them in all colors and genders and walks of life for this kind of mentoring to happen. It acknowledges that everyone is gifted and fearfully and wonderfully made and intended to use their talents for the good of all. It doesn't work so well when some people are relegated to the corner in a separate place and someone else gets credit for their work.

Another lesson of this movie was the importance of white people getting out of the way to allow for social change. Had the white boss, Mr. Harrison, kept all the power to himself we may have never landed on the moon. He broke down barriers to let the giftedness in. This takes humility and courage. Black history month is for everyone because we are all in this world together. As we remember the history and the stories of the past we can celebrate our gains and be challenged to do a better job of empowerment and eliminating the hiding of anyone.


