Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship Application

WHO: Graduating Seniors: The Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior who is an active member of a congregation in the Milford Area Ministerial Association, who plans to enroll in a college or university. A letter of support from the student's Pastor must be included with the application.

WHAT: A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded.

REQUIREMENTS: Along with a cover letter introducing the student, an essay is to be submitted. The topic of Essay is: "How have the life and teachings of Dr. King affected your life as an individual, and contributed to your ability to be a community builder?" As a future collegian; grammar, spelling, and punctuation will be considered.

DUE DATE: The essay must be typed and returned to your Pastor, electronically, prior to May 1, 2018.

PRESENTATION: The Scholarship check will be presented to the recipient in time for the 2018 fall semester. A Certificate will also be presented to the recipient at the 2019 Martin Luther King Day service.
