Psalm 1: 1-2 tells us, "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on His law he meditates day and night." These are always relevant words to focus on but as we come into this season of Lent, this scripture is more important to remember.

We can either follow the counsel of the world or the counsel of the Word. Psalm 1 tells us that we should make God's word our delight and meditate on it consistently, both day and night. Focusing on the Word is one of the major ways we get closer to God. The Word also gives us spiritual life. James 1:18 explains that "In fulfillment of His own purpose He gave us birth by the word of truth, so that we would become a kind of first fruits of His creatures."

The beginning of Lent is the time to start fresh once again. We often use these 40 days to work on what we can "give up" as a type of sacrificial offering or what we "can increase or add" in the areas of spiritual disciple and/or service. It's a lot like New Years when we make our resolutions to become more of who we want to be.

Let's use the 40 days of Lent to become more diligent in our spiritual disciplines so that habits can form and we will continue to grow as Christians all year round. And to God be the glory forever.

HELP US REACH NEW PEOPLE THROUGH WORSHIP

Avenue is continuing to look for ways to reach new people while improving the worship experience on Sunday mornings. We would like to extend the reach of our worship services by live streaming our gatherings on the internet. This would make our worship services available to shut-ins, those who are sick and traveling, as well as those who may be new to the area and checking out churches. Once services are complete, video of the services would be archived on our website or on a platform such as YouTube for those who want to view them later.

While part of our sound system was replaced previously, there are still upgrades that will allow our sound system to be as clear as possible, helping everyone hear the service better and providing the best sound for live streaming. Our wireless microphones are currently out of compliance with the FCC and need to be replaced. We would also like to upgrade our monitors to in-ear monitors, which would reduce the noise coming from the chancel and making the speakers in the Sanctuary sound clearer.

The total cost of the project is \$50,000. As this is not a budgeted item, we are looking to see if there are members who would like to contribute to the project. Your contribution will enable high quality sound and as well as the digital distribution of our worship services on Sunday mornings and beyond.


