## Martin Luther King, Jr., Scholarship Application

**WHO: Graduating Seniors.** The Martin Luther King, Jr., Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior who is an active member of a congregation in the Milford Ministerial Association, who also plans to enroll in a college or university.

**WHAT: One \$1,000 scholarship** will be awarded.

**REQUIREMENTS:** 1) A letter of support from each student's *Pastor* must be included with this application; 2) Each *applicant* will submit **a cover letter** introducing themselves; and, 3) An essay is to be submitted, addressing this question: **"How have the life and teachings of Dr. King affected your life as an individual, and contributed to your ability to be a community builder?"** As a future collegian, grammar, spelling and punctuation, will be considered.

**DUE DATE:** The essay must be typed and **returned to your Pastor**, electronically, prior to April 30, 2021. Remember: Along with this essay, and letter of introduction, a pastor's recommendation must be included.

**PRESENTATION:** Only one Scholarship check will be presented to a recipient, in time for the 2021 fall semester. A Certificate will also be presented to the recipient at the 2022 Martin Luther King Day service.
